



Northallerton BID Procurement Policy

Northallerton BID* is committed to supporting local businesses within the BID Boundary and keeping as much of the predicted £1M generated on behalf of the BID within the local community as possible. As a result, the BID undertake to offer preferential terms to suppliers who are levy payers (either mandatory via Hambleton District Council or voluntary to the BID).

Therefore if a BID member applies to supply the BID with any products and services, the BID undertake to give preferential terms to them in procurement given the following conditions**;

- The BID levy paying company*** are able to deliver the work to an excellent standard, on time and within the budget specified.
- The BID levy paying company quotation is within 20% of the cheapest quote available.
- The BID levy paying company is up to date with its levy payments.

*BID stands for Business Improvement District

**The exception to this policy would be when using grant funding, where public sector procurement rules would automatically apply.

*** A BID levy paying company means a company who pays a levy charge to Northallerton BID company either via mandatory charging from Hambleton District Council or a voluntary charge paid direct to the BID company.

Northallerton BID company is limited by guarantee and was formed in April 2017 after a successful ballot of levy paying businesses in October 2016.
